What facilities changes are needed to improve accessibility?

Paving into to the bath house for accessibility

Hearing – improve hearing capacity of worship area

Walking - level paths which could be used by disabled people

Allergies

Traveling – ramp entrance, sleeping if not able to go upstairs.

Do you for see any changes to any out buildings?

Barns – Eastern lean to – leave it. Keep the original barn as it is. Remember the south wall needs securing in the next 5 years.

Milk house parlor - remove

Silos – Could be renovated.

Grain bin – keep to consider apartment, sleeping room

Machine shed – keep as long as it pays for itself

Chicken house (long building with corrugated siding) – Get rid of it.

Or maybe keep west end of the building the concrete foundation.

Wood burner – consider selling it.

Pond – Diane Dennis will look toward keep it operating. If not her, we need to find someone to care for it. *Note: ECC has recommended a water feature on the grounds.*

What considerations are important to renovation of the kitchen in the Clear Creek House?

Replace or keep stove and oven unit, oven does not work, dishwasher not working. Recycle center installation, remove trash compacter

A new fridge has been purchased.

New microwave is needed.

What is the potential use for the garage behind the Clear Creek house?

Handicap accessible sleeping space and bathroom

Care-taker facility

Sleeping space for yearly meeting.

Cooling place for elderly.

Could be enlarged

Footings are good. Crack – fill the crack

Fixing up the garage for these purposes.

Other concerns at Clear Creek House

Breezeway and doorway to the basement need improvement

Remove cistern

What do we need to improve the bath house on the campground?

More cleanable surfaces

Extending showers – 4 more – two per side

Compare renovating existing showers to replace showers

Windows – renovate or repair.

Toilets – too low so slow, wastes water
